VOTING NOTICE

More nominations than required were received and an election will be held.
Candidates are listed on a separate schedule in the order they will appear on the ballot paper.

VOTING AT 2 LOCATIONS

Voting will take place at both the foyer of the main Club at 55 Campbell Street Blacktown, and at the Workers Sports Club at 170 Reservoir Road Blacktown at the following times:

THURSDAY, 8 APRIL to MONDAY 12 APRIL 2021
from 10.00 am to 7.00 pm daily

The Roll cut-off date was Sunday 28 February (the end of February). Current members who have renewed by then and new members who have submitted an application by then (and are subsequently accepted) can vote. Any new member joining after the end of February is not eligible to vote.

Members will be voting to elect 9 directors.

The method of voting will be First Past the Post. Members will be requested to mark their ballot papers with CROSSES. Ticks and numbers will also be accepted.

Members must vote for at least 1 candidate and may vote for up to 9 candidates.
Eligible members must produce their current membership card or other acceptable identification and sign to receive a ballot paper.

Information supplied by the Candidates will be available to members and displayed in the voting area during the hours of voting.

Counting of votes will take place at the Club in Campbell Street commencing at 10.15 on Tuesday 13 April 2021.

POSTAL VOTING

Members unable to attend the Club during the hours of voting may apply for a postal vote, using the approved form. Application forms are available from the Club or the Returning officer. The completed application form must be returned direct to the Returning Officer with adequate time for the Returning Officer to post out and receive back the ballot paper.

Completed postal ballot papers must be received by the Returning Officer by 7.00 pm, Monday 12 April 2021.

ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE POSITIONS

The Returning Officer will attend the Annual General Meeting at 9.00 on Sunday 18 April to invite and accept nominations for the Executive positions and conduct any ballots necessary for these positions.

Only the 9 elected Directors are eligible to stand as candidates for the executive positions and only those eligible members in attendance at the AGM may vote
